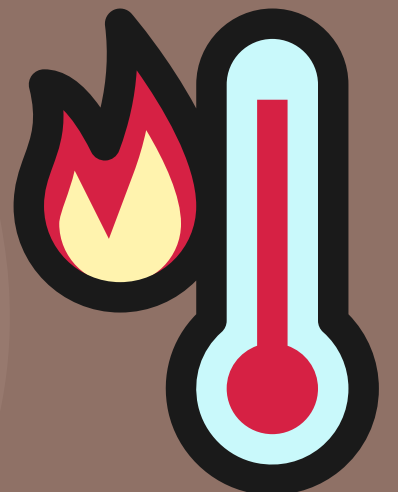
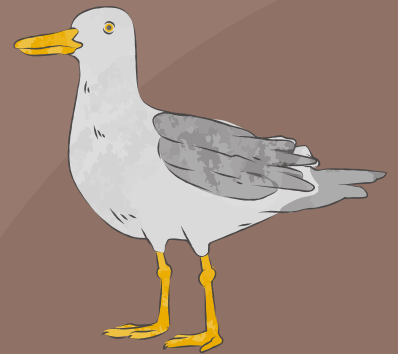

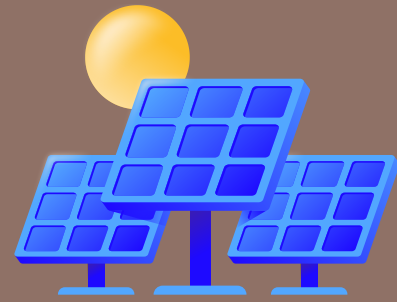

HERE ARE FOUR PRIMARY REASONS WHY MANY CURRENT SUSTAINABILITY SOLUTIONS FAIL



1. Lack of a Holistic Approach: Many environmental projects are implemented without a comprehensive understanding of consumer behavior and lifestyle. Without changing how consumers think and act, these projects remain incomplete and often fail.



2. Inadequate Feasibility Studies: Most environmental initiatives overlook essential feasibility studies and life cycle assessments. Understanding the full impact of a project from start to finish is critical for its success, which the owner of the project is not willing to do.



3. Long-Term Commitment Required: Sustainability projects should be viewed as long-term endeavors that assess the entire life cycle—from cradle to cradle—in a circular economy. Short-term thinking often undermines their effectiveness.



4. Focus on Technology Over Conservation: Often, project owners prioritise technological solutions or trendy concepts while neglecting fundamental principles like conservation, recycling, repairing, reusing, and reclaiming resources. This leads to increased consumerism rather than sustainable practices. For example, in times of water scarcity, the immediate response tends to be digging more borewells instead of promoting conservation. We need to change the trend to pro environment choices.

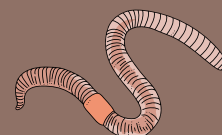
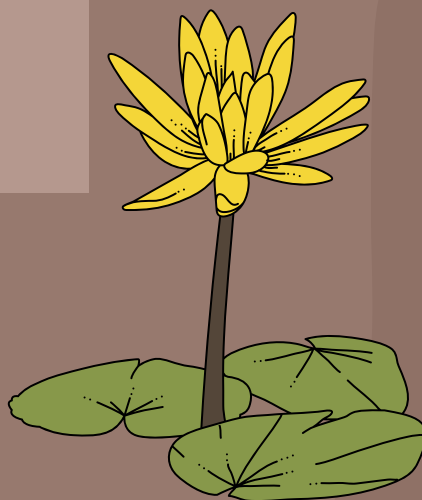


Additionally, governments and stakeholders often prioritize economic growth over sustainability and conservation, resulting in a lack of awareness and urgency regarding conservation efforts. Many people do not feel motivated to conserve resources because they don't perceive an immediate need, despite the pressing issues posed by climate change, such as rising temperatures, increasing disasters, resource scarcity, and contamination impacting our health and food chain.
